## PRINCIPALS REPORT

Mr. Cinnamon was not able to attend the meeting, Becky Reever sat in his place. Kindergarten round up is April 26th and information has already been sent out. PTA representation is needed with contact information if someone would like to join. Information about the Kindergarten play date has not been publicized.

## **DEVIN HEATH - WORLD FAIR**

Kids are focused on food rather than the projects. It can be a distraction and chaotic. Ideas to increase interest in the completed projects include:

- Remove food from fair? Majority of kids and parents like the food aspect.
- Food at lunch in separate part of Gym? This would require parent volunteers, and there may not offer enough time for children to go through lunch line and world fair food.
- Create a scavenger hunt? Each child come up with a question about his country and this question be placed on a list of questions for a scavenger hunt. That way kids are learning about each country. Once questions are answered they may proceed to the food table. (Limit scavenger hunt questions to 10-15)
- Create a passport book for the scavenger hunt, enough stamps go to food table. Concern about offering food as a reward.
- Food should be offered on the way out of the fair.
- Some kids may feel pressure to give stamps when not earned.
- Each child write something down that they learned about a country that they didn't know before. Number of items could be depended on age of child. (Example: kindergarten could draw pictures - maybe 3 things. 5th graders write down 10 things). May proceed to food table when completed.
- Children participating in the fair miss out on food and other projects in the past. Allow participants to start 20 minutes earlier than other kids.

Date is May 18th. Call for volunteers will be sent out. A request could also be sent home in the enrichment folders. Volunteers will be needed to man food table. 12:45-3:00. Contact Devin Heath: dheath@usd497.org to volunteer. There should be enough room to set up while 5th grade is eating lunch.
