Introducing Corldey Marathon Club



Classroom Volunteers Needed in April



Can you give a day to help out? If so, read on!

Each spring 3rd through 5th grade students take state assessments. During this time, the resource teachers and paraprofessionals are pulled from their regular class schedules to help administer state assessments to students. This is difficult for the students and classrooms that rely on these teachers and paraprofessionals.

Our goal is to provide volunteers on these days to fulfill some of the duties normally done by special education teachers and paraprofessionals. If you agree to help, you may work with a small group of students, an individual student or simply provide an extra set of hands in a classroom.

Volunteers will get an orientation prior to their volunteer day. On the day you volunteer, you will check in at 8:45 am, get a CVD (Cordley Volunteer of the Day) badge, and follow a schedule, helping in different classrooms throughout the day. We cannot guarantee that you will be in your child's classroom, but you WILL get to eat lunch with your student!

Volunteers are needed on the following dates: April 2, 3, 5, 6, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 16, 17, 18 and 26 (kindergarten roundup). Let's try to fill all 12 days!
